## Homeschool Funding

State-funded Education Savings Accounts (ESAs) have transformed the educational landscape by providing families with annual awards typically ranging from \$5,000 to \$10,000 per student. Leading programs include Arizona (averaging 10,261), Utah (7,500), and Florida (\$8,000), while newer initiatives in Texas and Alabama offer specific awards of \$2,000 for homeschoolers. As of 2026, over 20 states have enacted these programs, with 12 offering universal eligibility to ensure all students can access public funding for customized learning regardless of household income.

These funds empower parents to act as "educational general contractors," unbundling traditional instruction into a personalized portfolio of private tutors, core curriculum, and online platforms. Outschool is an approved vendor in over 15 states, allowing families to use ESA funds through direct marketplaces like ClassWallet and Odyssey or via reimbursement for 140,000+ approved classes. Beyond state-level ESAs, families can supplement their budgets using federal 529 plans—which now allow tax-free withdrawals of up to \$10,000 per student for K-12 expenses—or private philanthropic resources like HSLDA Compassion grants
